For the program year beginning July 1, 2019, the City of Bristol has been notified that it will receive \$648,928 from the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). There is \$17,260 to re-program from 2018-2019, and \$17,000 in Program Income. The total amount available for 2019-2020 funding will therefore be **\$683,188**.
