## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

There will be a Public Hearing of the Charter Revision Commission to be held on Tuesday, March 16, 2021 at 7:00 PM at City Hall, 111 N. Main Street, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Meeting Room, Bristol, Connecticut. The purpose of the meeting is to receive public input on the proposed draft report's changes to the charter.

## **Proposed Charter Changes:**

- a. Re-numbering of the entire City Charter, Sections 1-66.
- b. Sections 12 and 18, City Treasurer, change the City Treasurer from an elected to an appointed position, provide for an appointment process and making a technical change replacing the term "personnel director" with "director of human resources".
- c. Section 8, Registrars of Voters, change the term of office from a two (2) year term to a four (4) year term beginning with the November 2022 election.
- d. Sections 9, 12 and 12A, to change the term of office from Mayor from a two (2) year term to a four (4) year term beginning with the November 2023 election, and to make technical changes to sections 2, 9, 13, 14, 40, 45 and 50 to accommodate a four (4) year term for the Mayor.
