1. The Ordinance Committee was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Council Member Preleski

4. Old Business
 - a. Solid Waste – Sec. 10 – General Revisions

Council Member Fortier introduced this subject. There are many changes because they need to reflect current practice. Mr. Rogozinski said that these have been submitted to the Public Works Board for their input and anticipates approval at the next board meeting. These changes protect both the City and the residents as it reflects both the requirements and the services that the City provides. He reviewed how the Ordinance is organized and provided a review and synopsis of key areas. He also pointed out that Section 10.5 involves Zoning so he also sent the revisions to Zoning and the Fire Marshall for input and did receive back their comments. Further revisions will remove any duplications. In addition, Section 10.7 was also sent to other departments for input. There was discussion and Mr. Rogozinski answered questions.

There was brief discussion about the date referenced for the changes, and Council Member Fortier reviewed a number of possible corrections. The numbering of the sections was also reviewed. Mr. Rogozinski and Mr. Conlin will review all the items again.

The final version will be hopefully ready for the Public Works meeting. This will be looked at again at the next Ordinance meeting.
