The lease shall contain a 60 day termination clause. I further MOVE that this matter be referred to

the Corporation Counsel to prepare and/or review any necessary documents. I further MOVE that the Mayor, or acting Mayor, be authorized to execute any necessary documents to effectuate the same. **All voted in favor.**
