New Business: Assistant Director Krueger is organizing a Golf Tournament for the Senior Center to be held at Pequabuck Golf Course on Thursday, May 23, 2019. This will also serve as a fundraiser for the center.

Any other business: Executive Director Tomascak reported that the statistics for the past month is as follows: In February, we had 2,164 participants, Total membership is 6,634, with 16 members deceased and 44 new members. Our fundraiser total to date is \$13,209.00.

Executive Director Tomascak reported that our upcoming programs include Team Trivia night, April 12th, Entertainment April 26, Class Registration April 17, Pictures April 16 & 17, and the Olympics in May. The Community Gardens will be starting back up on April 5. We are also having a Life After Loss group start up on the third Monday of every month facilitated by Lauren Scappaticci.
