 - b. Sec. 7-17 Open Burning Amendments

Council Member Fortier made a motion to move Sec. 7-17 as amended to City Council to set a Public Hearing. Council Member Hahn seconded the motion, all voted in favor – motion passed.
5. New Business
 - a. Consideration of Section 3-32 for removal; Public Dances

Council Member Fortier inquired if the items to be removed has been sent to Chief Gould. **Council Member Fortier made a motion to recommend the removal of Sections 3-32 to 3-38 unless they hear otherwise from Chief Gould, and to send to City Council to set a Public Hearing.
