Executive Director Tomascak reported that our upcoming programs include James Michael who will be singing Broadway tunes on April 26, The Advocates Tag Sale on April 27, The Triad Conference on May 2, The Wii State Championships on May 3, A Mother's Day Dinner on May 10, A Senior Prom on May 16, The Bristol Brass and Wind on May 21, A Golf Tournament on May 23, and Olympics games the whole month of May.
