1. The Ordinance Committee was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Council Member Preleski
2. Approval of Minutes
 - a. **Council Member Hahn made a motion to accept the minutes of the Regular Meeting of May 4, 2021, seconded by Council Member Fortier. All present voted in favor, minutes accepted.**

Motion made by Council Member Fortier, that Item 4.c. (Sec. 22-43 through 22-62 regarding Private Sewage Disposal Systems) should be pulled off the agenda and record and should not be recommended to be sent to City Council. Council Member Hahn seconded the motion. Council Member Fortier said that they are waiting for the Superintendent of Sewer to get back to us to make sure that these items in this particular section are no longer covered by the City but handled by the State entities. **All present voted in favor. Motion passed.**

Council Member Preleski reported that no one presented at the Public Hearings.

Council Member Hahn made a motion to send to City Council for adoption to delete items 4a., 4b., 4d., and 4e. Council Member Fortier seconded the motion. All present voted in favor. Motion passed.

5. New Business
 - a. Consideration of amendments to section 2-68 – General Government Retirement Board

Council Member Preleski reported that the Mayor has received a memo (letter) regarding this item from the President of Local 233. They have asked for representation from that union on the general retirement board. The composition of the General Retirement Board is located in Section 2-68.

Council Member Preleski reported there are currently 12 members with 4 union representatives and said that if added, there would be 13 members, 5 from local unions. Discussion. This is the only union not represented in this board. This will be tabled for the next agenda. Attorney Conlin will draft something for the next meeting and will be sending a note to Pat Palmese.
