## **CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Hahn called the Thursday, July 9, 2020 Real Estate Committee Public Hearing meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

## **ITEM #1 – THE LEASE OF A PORTION OF CITY OWNED PROPERTY IDENTIFIED AS 75 BATTESTA ROAD (ASSESSOR’S MAP 3, LOT 31 TO D’AMATO REALTY ONE, LLC**

Attorney Steeg stated he need to make a clarification on the record as to the Leasee. The name of the entity should be D’Amato Associated, LLC and not D’Amato Realty One, LLC.

Attorney James Ziogas represents D’Amato Associates, LLC and spoke on their behalf. He stated the company is interested in leasing a portion of property owned by the City of Bristol which is part of the Water Pollution Control plant. D’Amato intends to utilize the leased premises in conjunction with its adjacent owned property at 400 Middle Street and utilize it for ground storage. D’Amato will maintain and secure the premises. The lease would contain provisions for one year termination notification for any portion of the premises in the event the

Water Pollution Control needed to expand. The terms of the lease would be for ten years with five, five year option periods. The annual lease would be \$3,300 which would be paid in monthly installments of \$275.00 based on the presumed pro-rated 10% real estate tax collection of the land's valuation (\$821,100) for 1.5 acres of the parcel's total 14.9 acreage. Lease rate for options periods would be based on the same valuation calculation.
