### Summary:

On Sunday, May 30, 2021, Bristol Police Department (BPD) officers were dispatched to Crowley RV located at 9 Barber Street for a report of shots fired.

Responding officers observed several bullet holes in the windows to the business. The business was closed and there were no injuries. A similar shots fired incident occurred in Southington, CT shortly after.

The investigation was assigned in BPD Criminal investigation Division. The suspect was identified as Floyd Gollnick (DOB 9/22/46) of 91 Grove Street; Southington, CT. A warrant for his arrest was signed on 8/6/21 charging Gollnick with Criminal Mischief 1<sup>st</sup> degree (53a-115), Illegal Discharge or a Firearm (53-203), Reckless Endangerment 2<sup>nd</sup> degree (53a-64) and Breach of Peace 2<sup>nd</sup> degree (53a-181). At the time the warrant was issued, Gollnick was in the custody of the Connecticut Department of Corrections for other criminal activities.

On 10/19/2021, Gollnick was transported to New Britain Superior Court where the warrant was served.
