Senior Volunteer Tax Relief Program

July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023

(Volunteer hours worked)

Applications taken Feb 01, 2023 – June 30, 2023

Tax Credit: \$300.00 per household

Eligibility: Bristol Resident 60 years of age or older, own real property as a Principal residence, annual income not to exceed \$45,000/single, or \$50,000 couple (**Income includes Total Income- not including Social Security**).

Eligible residents must complete a minimum of 50 hours of volunteer service during the fiscal year July 01, 2022 – June 30, 2023 at a non-profit agency within the City of Bristol. Tax credit is applied to the fiscal year July 01, 2023-June 30, 2024.

Upon completion of volunteer hours served, applicants must bring a signed letter from the volunteer organization verifying the volunteer service to: The Executive Director of the Department of Aging (Senior Center), located at 240 Stafford Avenue, Bristol, CT 06010, where they will receive a Volunteer Verification form.

Eligible residents must bring the Verification form received to the Assessor's Office, located in City Hall, beginning February 1, 2023 in order to complete the process as well as any reportable income forms and a completed IRS tax Return for 2022 (if you are required to file one). A brief application will be completed at this time.

Tax Relief funds allocated by the City shall not exceed \$24,000.00 for this program or 80 applicants.

Tax credits will be issued on a first come first serve basis and will be credited to the Real Estate bill fiscal year July 2023 – June 30, 2024.
