NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

There will be a Public Hearing of the Charter Revision Commission to be held on Tuesday, March 16, 2021 at 7:00 PM at City Hall, 111 N. Main Street, 3rd Floor Meeting Room, Bristol, Connecticut. The purpose of the meeting is to receive public input on the proposed draft report's changes to the charter.

Proposed Charter Changes:

- a. Re-numbering of the entire City Charter, Sections 1-66.
- b. Sections 12 and 18, City Treasurer, change the City Treasurer from an elected to an appointed position, provide for an appointment process and making a technical change replacing the term "personnel director" with "director of human resources".
- c. Section 8, Registrars of Voters, change the term of office from a two (2) year term to a four (4) year term beginning with the November 2022 election.
- d. Sections 9, 12 and 12A, to change the term of office from Mayor from a two (2) year term to a four (4) year term beginning with the November 2023 election, and to make technical changes to sections 2, 9, 13, 14, 40, 45 and 50 to accommodate a four (4) year term for the Mayor.
