1. Call to Order

Council Member, Hahn called the meeting to order at 6:06 p.m.

2. Memorial Boulevard Bridge Project

A. Director Rogozinski requested approval to expand the Memorial Boulevard Bridge Project to include: replacement of an additional 145 l.f. of retaining wall and the associated funding. Although failure is not imminent, the section contains early signs of failure and degradation will continue, ultimately necessitating replacement. Doing so now results in a complete replacement of the retaining wall, affords superior constructability and efficiency. Consequently, complete replacement is most economical and structurally beneficial solution.

Motion: made by Commissioner Stawski and seconded, move to approve expansion of the Memorial Boulevard Bridge project to include complete retaining wall replacement and request Board of Finance approval for an additional appropriation, in the amount of \$750,000. Motion passed.

3. Tour

A. At 6:15 p.m. Director Rogozinski, Fleet Manager Divirgilio and Public Works Coordinator Nicastro: lead a tour of the Department of Public Works facilities and grounds at 95 Vincent P Kelly Road; gave updates regarding fleet, equipment and building maintenance; and discussed a program co-facilitated with the United Way, that was underway, "Farms to Families."

A. The new logo for Department of Public works vehicles was presented.
