Groups of 10 or less can start meeting in Room #109, our Arts and Ceramics rooms will be open to work on projects, There will be a Mother's Day Grab & Go meal sponsored by Sheriden Woods and Countryside Manor on Friday, May 7<sup>th</sup>, an Ice Cream give away on Wednesday, May 26<sup>th</sup>, and we will be starting our hiking up again as well. We are also exploring ways to open the Boutique and Coffee Shop again in the summer once a week outside.
